

New Port de Plaisance for Lyon?

The April 2008 edition of *'Fluvial'* the French Inland Waterways Magazine, reports that a new Port de Plaisance is being built at Lyon. This will be most welcome, since one of the most interesting cities in France has to date offered few mooring possibilities other than than a noisy quayside alongside a busy road.

The new Port will be on the left bank, about 1.5km downstream of the VNF offices on the Saône quay, in a newly excavated basin around which shops and offices are being developed.

It should be open in May, and reports would be welcome.
